

## RESERVE RECRUITABLE PERSONNEL

In the seven county area: Houston, Bibb Peach, Jones, Monroe, Crawford, and Twiggs the total population is 356,801 (U.S. Census 2000). The recruitable age bracket for the Reserves is 17 – 34 years old. That age group comprises 25.1% of the total population (89,442 individuals) for the seven counties combined. Based on the 2000 census there is ample population within the study area to support the needs of several Reserve units.

There are two local Reserve Units (ARC Units) at Robins Air Force Base:

- ? Headquarters Air Force Reserves
- ? Air National Guard (116<sup>th</sup> Air Control Wing)

The recruiting area for the Reserve Command is generally a 100-mile radius surrounding Robins Air Force Base. The total population for the 100 mile recruiting area is 1,372,179. For FY 2003, Air Force Reserve recruiting totaled 77 at Robins AFB, 61 individuals were from Georgia.
